

## ABOUT NEXEN

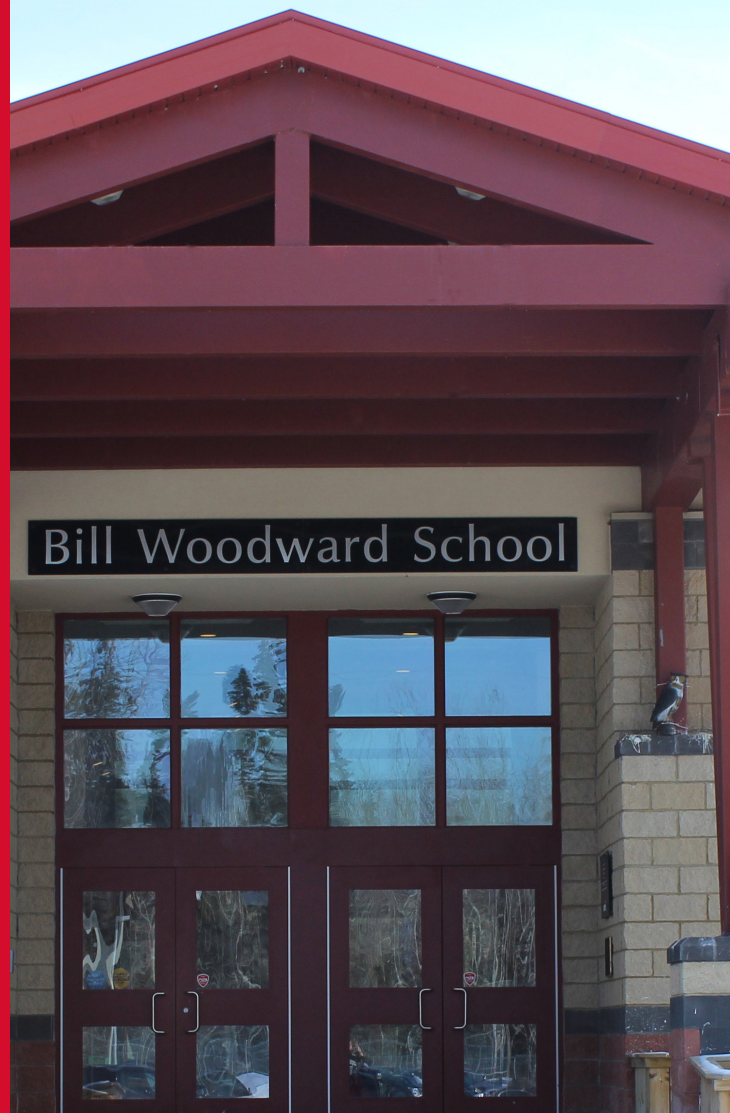

## WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible, you must be:

- A Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Graduating from Bill Woodward School in 2017.
- Entering full time studies for the first year of a bachelor degree program or diploma program or certificate program OR the first year of apprenticeship technical training (classroom studies) of an eligible apprenticeship program.

**NOTE:** This scholarship program is administered by Universities Canada. Universities Canada will handle the application process, recipient selection, and payment of scholarships to recipients on behalf of Nexen.

**Applications must be submitted by mail ONLY, directly to Universities Canada.**

## WHAT PROGRAMS DOES THE NEXEN SCHOLARSHIP – BILL WOODWARD SCHOOL SUPPORT?

- There are no restrictions on the program of study or discipline.
- Certificate programs must be of a minimum one year duration.
- Diploma programs must be of a minimum two years' duration.
- Degree programs must be of a minimum three years' duration.
- University preparatory programs in any jurisdiction are **not** eligible (e.g. CEGEPs, pre-university diploma).

## ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS

- Canadian, American and foreign educational institutions that have recognized degree/diploma-granting powers, or their affiliates (e.g. universities, colleges/CEGEPs - technical diploma). For foreign and private post-secondary institutions, you may be required to provide Universities Canada with documentation proving that the institution is properly accredited and that your program meets the program requirements of this scholarship.
- Alberta Apprenticeship Programs recognized under the Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act or recognized by any equivalent Canadian or US government agencies.

## WHAT IS THE VALUE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The amount of the scholarship depends on the type of educational program:

### UNIVERSITY/COLLEGE

- \$2,500 CAD per year towards tuition and other expenses for degrees, diplomas or certificates;
- Tenable for up to four years or until first degree/diploma is obtained, whichever occurs first.
- Tenable for up to two years or until first certificate is obtained, whichever occurs first.

### APPRENTICESHIP

- \$750 CAD for each period of apprenticeship technical training (classroom studies) for up to four years or until the apprenticeship program is completed or until the applicant has received a maximum of \$3,000, whichever occurs first.

## WHAT DOCUMENTS DO I NEED TO SUBMIT WITH MY APPLICATION?

You must provide:

- Official high school transcripts.
- Proof of registration from the educational institution you will be attending.

## ARE DEPENDENTS OF NEXEN EMPLOYEES ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THIS SCHOLARSHIP?

Students who are dependents of Nexen employees are eligible to apply for this scholarship as well as Nexen's Scholarship Program for Dependent Children of Employees. However, they are only able to accept one of the two awards.

## WHEN I COMPLETE MY PROGRAM, CAN I WORK FOR NEXEN?

## WHAT IS THE DEADLINE?

Universities Canada must receive your application by June 30, 2017. You will be notified in August whether or not you are awarded a scholarship.
